Note: In accordance with traditional practice, the pages of the separate Testaments and Apocryphal/Deuterocanonical Books are numbered independently. Thus, the Introductions to the Pentateuch, the Apocrypha, and the Gospels are respectively the first page of the Hebrew Bible, the first page of the Apocryphal/Deuterocanonical Books, and the first page of the New Testament. As an aid to the reader the page numbers in the lists of contents are distinguished by the abbreviations HB, AP, and NT. The essay and reference material at the back of the book continue the numbering of the New Testament and carry the abbreviation ES.
